

Scouts SA Roadmap: Return to Face to Face Scouting

Step 1: Communication

Week beginning 25 May

- Communication to Leaders and Adults in Scouting
- Continue Scouting@Home

Week beginning 1 June

- Communication to all members
- Continue Scouting@Home

Face to Face Scouting remains suspended

Step 2: Preparation

Week beginning 8 June

- Finalise resources to support restart
- Checklists, guidelines
- Release on Q-Store

Week beginning 15 & 22 June

- Restart sessions for Groups and Teams outlining guidelines and requirements for returning to face to face

Face to Face allowed for Forums and Adult Meetings once checklist approved

Step 3: Returning

Week Beginning 29 June

- Groups/Teams to complete checklist. Once checklist completed, then
- Unit Councils can meet for Term 3 planning
- Small/Patrol based activities can be conducted

Week Beginning 13 July

- Communication to all members with reminders re attendance at Scouting

Week Beginning 20 July

- Face to Face Unit meetings can resume

Face to Face allowed in line with above schedule: Adult Meetings, Unit Council and then Unit meetings

Preparation

25 May - 15 June

- Communication to Leaders
- Communication to Members
- Finalisation of resources and checklists
- Scouting@Home continues

Face to Face Scouting remains suspended

Education

15 June - 29 June

- Workshops for Districts, Groups and Teams to provide details
- Adult meetings (subject to government advice) can take place as long as physical distancing, cleaning and hygiene measures are followed
- Scouting@Home continues

Face to Face adult meetings allowed in line with guidelines ONCE approved

Restart

29 June onwards

- Unit Council meetings can occur
- Small/Patrol based activities can resume - hikes, unit council meetings, patrol activities etc

As of 29 June 1 person per 2sq/m is the defined venue limit

Face to Face allowed - 29 June (Unit Council), then 20 July (Section meetings) ONCE approved
