If advised by an infected individual or a Scout Group that an infected person has visited a Scouting property, Scouts SA will immediately contact SA Health to establish any action required by the Association and the Scout Group. Scouts SA will ensure that the Association follows all directions given by SA Health and ensure all actions are undertaken promptly and diligently.
2	Follow the direction from SA Health. Scouts SA to enforce closure of the Scout Hall for the period as determined by SA Health and ensure that all undertakings made of the Scout Group are performed promptly and diligently.
3	After being cleared of COVID-19, and after the approval of SA Health, the previously infected person may re-join Scouting activities.	The Scout Group may resume activities only when cleared to do so by Scouts SA Headquarters.	Scouts SA to authorise the resumption of Scouting activities upon the advice of SA Health.
