ABOUT JAMX

JamX is a one of a kind major scouting event for South Australian Scout and Venturer Scout members.

The event will be held at Yakka Park, Lucindale across 4 - 9 January 2022

ELIGIBILITY

SCOUT ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a current registered youth member at the time of application and through until at least 11th Jan 2022
- Must have met the requirements, before 30th November 2021, for:
 - Program Essentials Milestone 1, as well as Outdoor Adventure Skills Stage 3 in Bushcraft, Bushwalking, and Camping
 - Must have completed 5 nights camping in the outdoors with the Unit or Patrol, as a Scout. (as per level stage 3 camping requirements)
- Have approval from the Unit Council
- Have approval from the Event Co - Director
- Have consent from their parents/guardian

VENTURER SCOUT ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a current registered Venturer Scout youth member at the time of application and through until at least 11 January 2022
- If the Venturer turns 18 years old at any point during JamX, must hold evidence of meeting the legislative requirements to work with children in South Australia - Refer to Branch Guidance for 18 year old Venturers for further information
- Have completed Program Essentials Introduction to Section for Venturer Scouts, as well as Outdoor Adventure Skills Stage 3 in each of Bushcraft, Bushwalking, and Camping
- Have a desire to do active support of the Scout section, along with leading and assisting activities
- Be recommended by the Unit Council as being of excellent character, a good role model to Scouts, and have the skills and abilities to undertake the activity (or other tasks) nominated on the application form
- Have approval from the Event Co - Director
- Have consent of their parents/guardian

HOW TO APPLY

Applications for JamX 2022 must be completed using MyScout.

All applicants must apply individually - there is no option to register members of your Unit in bulk for JamX

Applications close at 11.59pm on Sunday 26 September 2021. No further applications can be accepted after this time.



A \$100 initial payment is required upon application. Upon applying, an invoice for the total amount will be issued, the \$100 initial payment should be paid against this invoice using the payment instructions provided (Online credit card payments of partial invoices unfortunately is not available at this time).

Applications will only be accepted once this initial payment has been made.

EVENT CANCELLATION

Event cancellation due to SA Government Covid-19 based directions is a reasonable risk to this event and should be considered by all participants and their families. Scouts SA is unable to obtain sufficient insurance cover for this event and therefore losses may result.

A cancellation of JamX due to a SA Government COVID-19 based direction or declaration, or a perceived imminent occurrence of such a declaration, will result in a refund to participants of all recoverable moneys from the event.

As expenses will have been incurred in the preparation of the event, the full event fee cannot be refunded. Should the event be cancelled on or before 31 Dec 2021, participants will forfeit up to \$150 of their event fee.

Scouts SA recognises the financial impact and disappointment such an occurrence will be for families, and has adopted an approach where families and Scouts SA will share in the losses. Scouts SA has taken a considered approach to this from a basis of fairness and to ensure ongoing organisational viability.

MEDICAL OBLIGATIONS & SPECIAL DIETS

Medical, Emergency Contact and Dietary Requirement information is required by the JamX Event Team for all participants.

Operoo is the ScoutsSA preferred platform for online profiles and electronic forms. As part of the JamX preparation process, a request to share participants Medical, Emergency Contact and Dietary Requirements will be made through Operoo to members primary email contact.

Should the applicant's medical, emergency contact and special diet details change prior to JamX, it is the obligation of the applicant (or parent/guardian) to update their Operoo profile prior to the commencement of JamX.

WAIVER FORM

Should an activity require participants to have a completed waiver form signed by their parent/guardian, parent/guardian consent will be obtained through a JamX Operoo form. Should a participant (or their parent/guardian) choose not to complete the activity, a substitute activity will be arranged. No refunds will be provided.

FEE INCLUSIONS

- Full JamX program, including offsite and onsite activities. Some optional activities may be made available at an additional cost
- All accommodation costs from Tuesday 4 January 2021 to Sunday 9 January 2011, inclusive
- Travel to and from offsite activities
- Coach transport from a location close to group halls (or other arrangements for Scouts in regional areas)
- All meals for the duration of JamX
- One (1) JamX event badge and one (1) JamX t-shirt

VENTURER SCOUTS

Venturer Scouts will operate with some unique JamX considerations under the guiding principles of:

- Building skills in outdoors, leadership or group facilitation is a good outcome. This journey can start well before JamX
- A Venturers ability to participate in the fun is a consistent review theme from Venturer Youth Forums
- A service mindset makes useful contributors to society, and fun can be had on the way

Venturer Scouts are able to participate care-free in the majority of the JamX program, but also blend in leading and assisting through operating in assigned roles for up to two of the JamX days (or equivalent). This allocation will be overseen by a JamX Venturer Unit Council

Venturer Scouts will have the opportunity to identify their preferred role, which could include:

- Outdoor Adventure Skill based Assistant Activity Leader (e.g. Bushwalking, Caving, Cycling, Climbing, Paddling, Swimming, Snorkelling)
- Other Onsite or Offsite activity support
- Venturer Unit camp service
- Sites and Services team member
- Welfare team member
- Camplife entertainer
- Entertainment team tech crew or performer

- Membership of the JamX Venturer Unit Council

The Venturer Scout registration fee is discounted to \$420 in recognition of the value Venturers bring in these assigned roles to JamX.

Should a Venturer Scout elect not to take up leading and assist roles, the full participant fee of \$550 will be applicable.
