Safe Participant Flatwater Qualification (Youth) / Endorsement (Leader)
Valid for a maximum of three (3) years

Allows youth to **PARTICIPATE** in youth led paddling activities.
Refer to Scouts Australia (SA Branch) Activity Standard for Flatwater Canoeing and Kayaking on Protected (Inland) Waters

Does **NOT** allow leaders / youth to lead a paddling activity

To lead canoe and/or kayak paddling activities for participants you will need to progress to the Trained Participant level.
