## What is the purpose of my role?

The ABC (Comedy Capers Gang Show) works as part of the Branch Performing Arts Team to assist in the implementation of Performing Arts projects, with the objective of continually improving the profile and participation of Performing Arts as an integral part of the Scouting Program.

## How do I fit in?

Specifically, this position is the volunteer Commissioner responsible for overseeing the delivery of the Comedy Capers Gang Show (CCGS) program in accordance with Branch policies, directives and expectations, and representing the Branch Commissioner in the day-to-day delivery of the CCGS program in the best interests of Scouts SA. Your role is to facilitate a happy and sustainable learning environment for youth members in the Performing Arts space, culminating in live performance opportunities.

## How much time is required?

Time commitment will vary over the show season and in the off-season. The ABC CCGS is expected to be the liaison point between the CCGS cast & crew and the Branch, and represents Branch in overseeing the CCGS program.
